

# How to get to camp



Simply use a good road map to find your way to the Frankfort area. Then follow the handy map below to find the Camp Lookout parking lot. Be advised, however, that there is no telephone at the parking lot. If you need to arrive at a time other than our regular opening/closing times, please telephone from Frankfort before driving out to Lookout.

If you wish to contact other families in your area to share driving, contact the camp and we'll help you to set up carpooling groups.



We'll pick/drop off campers arriving and departing at Cherry Capitol airport in Traverse City, about an hour drive from camp. A nominal pickup charge will be levied against the camper's store account.

## Opening & Closing Days

**Unless noted otherwise, sessions begin on Sunday and end on Friday.**

On *opening days*, registration for the session takes place between **1pm** and **3pm**. Campers and families will be met by staff in the parking lot. After check in with the camp health officer and one of the directors, campers and parents will be transported to camp by pontoon boat. Counselors will meet campers and families upon their arrival at the dock.

On *closing days*, campers will be ready to leave shortly after lunch, **12:30pm** or so. We will move luggage from camp earlier so that most of it will be waiting in the parking lot by 12:30pm. Campers families are invited to come into camp when picking up their children. Pontoon boats will be running from **12:15pm** to **2:00pm**.
